## Resolution Supporting Administrative Uniformity of State Motor Carrier Procedures

- **Whereas,** Interstate motor carriers must comply with the multiple and non-uniform state taxation and regulation procedures of each state in which they operate; and,

- **Whereas,** the WASHTO subcommittee on Highway Transport has determined that its top priority is to achieve uniformity of motor carrier laws and regulations to the extent possible;
- **Now, therefore be it resolved,** that WASHTO supports efforts to achieve uniformity of motor carrier laws and regulations as a means to increase the efficiency and effectiveness of the states procedures; and,
- **Be it further resolved,** that this resolution be communicated to AASHTO, the U.S. Secretary of Transportation, and the National Governor's Association.
