Opposing Regulatory Expansion and Unfunded Mandates

- Whereas, the WASHTO states believe the processes and requirements needed to develop and deliver projects within the Federal-aid Highway program are already sufficiently rigorous; and
- Whereas, costs to pay for additional process requirements and mandates would reduce the resources needed for the basic highway and transit needs of the western states; and
- Whereas, many states and local governments have additional requirements that must be met before projects can be delivered based on state laws and local ordinances.
- **Now, therefore be it resolved,** that the WASHTO states urge Congress to streamline program and process requirements; and
- **Be it also resolved,** that the WASHTO states oppose new mandates and regulations that may impede project development and impose unfunded requirements on the program.
