Resolution 6-04

Urging Full Funding of Essential Air Service (EAS) Program as Authorized by Congress

- **Whereas**, the Essential Air Service (EAS) program is critical to the continuation of air service in the rural states, and
- **Whereas,** the EAS program costs have decreased significantly since the early 1980's when the program was first established, and
- **Whereas,** the program benefits all air service users, not just those living in the cities that receive subsidized service, and
- **Whereas,** since 1992, funding for the EAS program has come from the aviation trust fund which is derived from taxes on the users of the aviation system, and
- **Whereas,** air service is essential to the economic well-being of many small cities in rural America and to the country as a whole.
- **Now, therefore be it resolved,** that the Western Association of State Highway and Transportation Officials (WASHTO) encourages the United States Congress to continue to support the Essential Air Service program.
- **Be it further resolved,** that WASHTO Member Departments encourage their Governor and Congressional delegation to support continue funding of the EAS program to support air service in rural states.
