<b>Comments</b>
AK allows the applicant to transfer a valid annual to a new unit
ALB allows a transfer if original unit is destroyed or breaks down
AZ only transfers units on single trip permits
CO does not allow transfers on annuals
ID allows the applicant to transfer annuals to a new unit
MT The permit is not transferrable if issued for a truck-trailer-trailer or truck tractor-semitrailer-trailer-trailer combination of vehicles
NV allows the applicant to transfer a valid annual to a new unit
NM does not allow transfers on annuals under any circumstance
ND does not allow transfers on annuals under any circumstance
OK does not allow transfers on annuals under any circumstance
OR makes the applicant get a new annual for 8 dollars
SD allows a transfer if original unit is destroyed within one month of permit
TX does not allow transfers on annuals for breakdowns or sales
UT allows the applicant to transfer a valid annual to a new unit
WA allows transfers on annuals to a new unit
WY does not allow transfers on annuals under any circumstance
