COLORADO REVISED STATUTES

TITLE 42. VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC
REGULATION OF VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC
ARTICLE 4. REGULATION OF VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC
PART 5. SIZE - WEIGHT - LOAD

C.R.S. 42-4-510 (2017)

(1) (a) The department of transportation or any local authority with respect to highways under its jurisdiction may, upon application in writing and good cause being shown therefor, issue a single trip, a special, or an annual permit in writing authorizing the applicant to operate or move a vehicle or combination of vehicles of a size or weight of vehicle or load exceeding the maximum specified in this article...All state permits shall be issued in the discretion of the department of transportation...

C.R.S. 42-4-511

Permit standards - state and local (2) (a) Any permits which may be required by local authorities shall be issued in accordance with ordinances and resolutions adopted by the respective local authorities after a public hearing...(b) At least thirty days prior to such public hearing, the local authority shall transmit a copy of the proposed ordinance or resolution to the department of transportation for its comments, and said department shall make such comments in writing...

THIS INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT (“IGA” or “Agreement”) is entered into by and between the STATE OF COLORADO acting by and through the Department of Transportation (hereinafter called “State” or “CDOT”) and the CITY AND COUNTY OF DENVER, a municipal corporation of the State of Colorado, acting by and through the Department of Public Works (hereinafter called “City” or “Local Agency”). CDOT and the City may hereinafter be referred to collectively as “Parties” or individually as “Party.”

RECITALS

1. Pursuant to the Colorado Constitution, Article XIV, §18(2)(a), and C.R.S. §29-1-203, the Parties may cooperate or contract with each other to provide any function, service or facility lawfully authorized to each, and any such contract may provide for sharing of costs.

Use the form to the left to enter a trip that the truck(s) will use for this permit.

You have 6 options for entering your origin and destination locations:

- An address – Enter the street number, street, city and/or zip code.
- The intersection of two streets – Enter each of the streets and the city of the intersection location. The map will zoom into the intersection and may have several location markers for you to select from; COOPR produces turn-by-turn directions so choose the marker that best represents your location.
- Border crossings – If you are entering from another state or leaving Colorado, select your highway and the nearest city to where you will cross the state line.
- Lat/Lon/Map – If you have the geocode for your location, you may enter it. Example: 39.44404, -104.59091. You can also click Find after selecting Lat/Lon/Map to click a location on the map.
- Road & Mile Marker – Enter the road, mile marker and direction of travel.
- Landmark – Select from a dropdown of CO landmark locations.

You have the option to enter via points for your route.

- Highway – Enter a single highway or a series of highways you would prefer to travel on your trip.
- Find on Map – Click on "Select on Map" to open the map and select your highway via points.

Click **Validate and Run**. The router will attempt to generate a legal route for your truck based on the weight and load parameters you entered earlier. To edit your route click the expand arrows to access your routing options.

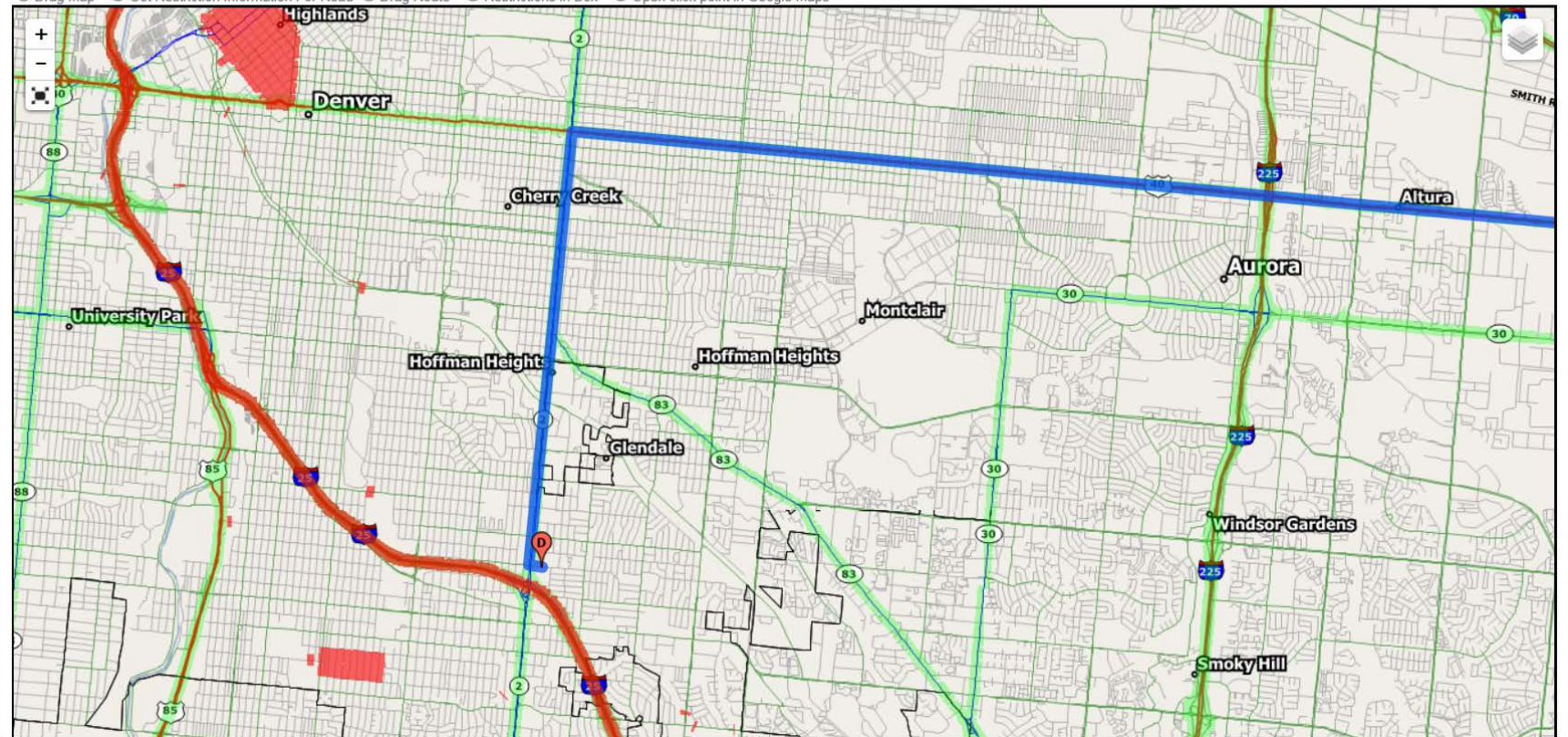

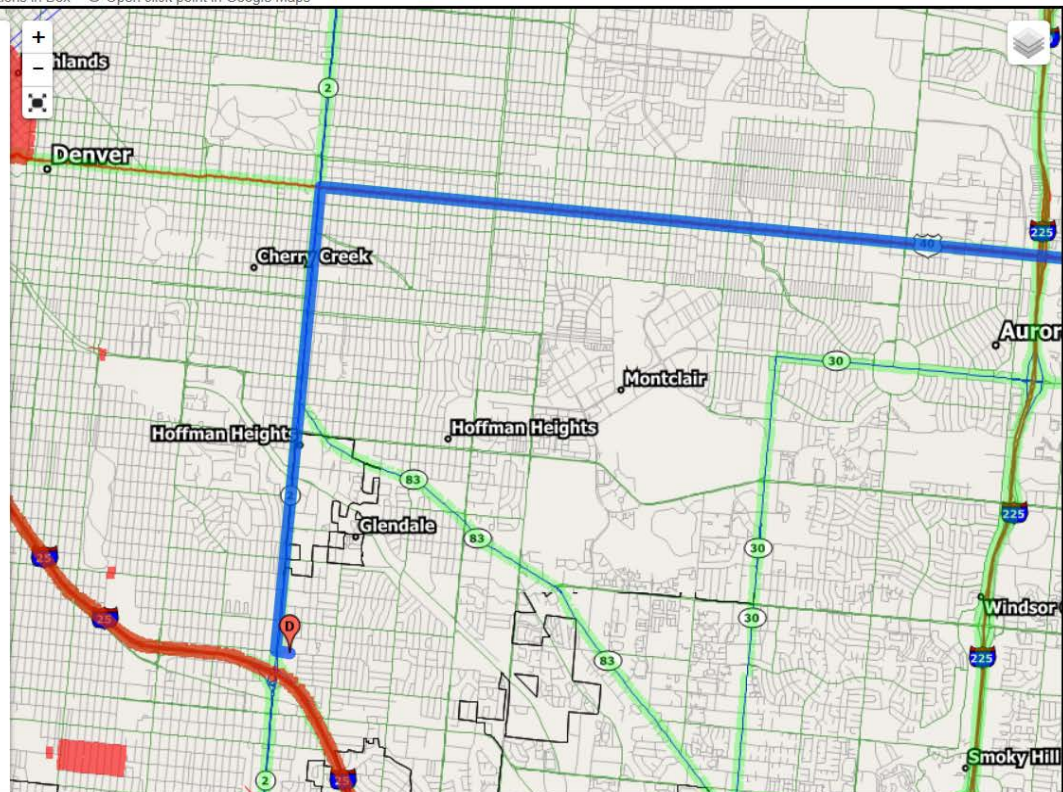

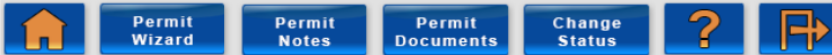
