Partnering Success Average of (1.5) Case filed/year in Court of Claims

2016: 792 Projects - \$1.43B Total Program

- Settlements of \$1,084,000 = 0.076%

2017: 778 Projects - \$1.85B Total Program

- Settlements of \$1,084,502 = 0.059%

2018: 785 Projects - \$1.85B Total Program

- Settlements of \$1,424,514 = 0.077%

2019: 736 Projects - \$1.49B Total Program

- Settlements of \$451,000 = 0.030%

2020: 711 Projects - \$1.27B Total Program

- Settlements of \$4,200,000 = 0.331%

2021: 699 Projects - \$1.63B Total Program

- Potential Settlements of \$1,388,764.46*
