Reinstatement of Non-Essential Expenditures (Amending Resolution 02-21)

WHEREAS, WASHTO temporarily suspended traditional expenses detailed in the WASHTO bylaws deemed non-essential by the WASHTO Treasurer and Vice President pursuant to Resolution 02-21;

WHEREAS, expenses related to Employee Memorials were brought out of suspension in October 2022;

WHEREAS, WASHTO has recovered from the budgetary constraints of previous years;

WHEREAS, WASHTO prioritizes the growth of new generations of employees and the facilitation of their engagement and learning at the regional and national levels;

WHEREAS, WASHTO recognizes the importance of the Hewes Award in honoring those who provide outstanding contributions to the highway development program in the Western Region of the United States:

WHEREAS, reimbursement of employee travel to AASHTO and WASHTO meetings would help new employees attend these meetings, expand the reach of AASHTO and WASHTO to new members, and properly honor Hewes Award recipients;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Western Association of State Highway and Transportation Officials, that WASHTO amend Resolution 02-21 to reinstate expenditures to fund AASHTO and WASHTO meeting attendance reimbursement and the Hewes Award.
